 **Refurbish / Donate****Refurbishing- Variation of Reuse**

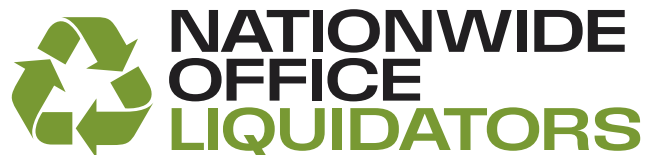
- Old items given a new life
